**Returning Adult Scholarship Application**

*\$1000 General Scholarship awarded by the Harford County Chamber of Commerce Education Foundation*

**General Criteria for Applicants**

Be a Harford County Resident who will continue post-secondary education at any school

Complete a minimum of 6 credits or equivalent per semester

Funds must be applied toward fees, books, and tuition

Check will be made payable to the post-secondary institution of the student's choice and to the recipient

Show evidence of financial need

Complete a Scholarship Application

You may apply for more than one scholarship, but can only be granted one award.

If you are applying for more than one scholarship, please submit a separate application / supporting material for each.

Those who poses a BS, BA or higher degree from a post-secondary school are not eligible.

The Scholarship Committee shall be composed of members of the Harford County Chamber of Commerce and sponsor representatives. The Scholarship Committee will select the award recipients. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to award the scholarship to the most overall qualified applicant based on any or all of the selection criteria. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.

- Applicant cannot have earned any post-secondary credits in the last school year (September through May).
- Application and supporting materials must be postmarked by **April 13th**.
- Awards will be announced in **May**.
- Presentation of scholarships to winners will take place at the Harford County Chamber of Commerce **June** Luncheon.
- Recipient will have until **December 31st** of award year to make final arrangements for use of scholarship funds.
