<b>Business, Finance, &amp; Information Technology Scholarship</b>	Based on funds available, \$1000 scholarship(s) will be awarded to applicant(s) pursuing a degree in accounting, finance, business administration, information technology, or marketing.	3.0 or above
<b>Health and Human Services Scholarship</b>	Based on funds available, \$1000 scholarship(s) will be awarded to applicant(s) pursuing a degree in government/public service, health service/personal care or hospitality, tourism and/or recreation.	3.0 or above
<b>Science, Technology, &amp; Engineering Scholarship</b>	Based on funds available, \$1000 scholarship(s) will be awarded to applicant(s) pursuing a degree in engineering, manufacturing, construction, environmental, agricultural, or natural resources, science and technology studies, or transportation technologies.	3.0 or above
<b>William B. Securro Teacher Education Scholarship</b>	A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to an applicant pursuing a degree in teaching.	3.0 or above

#### GENERAL CRITERIA FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIPS:

1. Be a Harford County resident currently in the senior year of high school, who will continue with post-secondary education as a full-time student in the designated field of the selected scholarship.
2. The applicant **must** register for a minimum 12 credits per semester beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> fall after high school graduation. \*\* If you are applying for a technical or trade school scholarship, please refer to the Technology/Trade Scholarship Application. \*\*
3. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average as listed on the Scholarship Summary Description. The Scholarship Committee may waive the GPA requirement upon documentation of special circumstances.
4. Complete a Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Application, complete the required essay and resume, and submit required supporting documentation as listed on the application.

The Scholarship Committee shall be composed of members of the Harford County Chambers of Commerce and sponsor representatives. The Scholarship Committee will select the award recipients. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to award the scholarship to the most overall qualified applicant based on any or all of the selection criteria. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.

- Applications and supporting materials must be postmarked by **April 3, 2020** to Harford County Chamber of Commerce, 108 South Bond Street, Bel Air, MD 21014. Applications may also be dropped off to Chamber office.
- Awards will be announced by **May 2020**.
- Presentation of the scholarship will take place at the Harford County Chamber of Commerce Education and Scholarship Breakfast to be held **June 12, 2020**.
- Recipient will have until **December 31, 2020** of award year to make final arrangements for use of scholarship funds.
